When you are buying a house, the agent targets in the S.I.A.[®]/MLS[®] system the properties that best match your needs. He also accompanies you during the visits and advises you through every step of a transaction, until you sign the notarial act.

The S.I.A.[®]/MLS[®] system is a powerful work tool reserved to the GMREB members. It is the most comprehensive database for real estate transactions, and is subject to stringent internal quality control. All GMREB agents and brokers can access it. They can select properties that best match their clients' needs.
